Testify Series - Paul & King Agrippa Acts 26 - April 22, 2018

How can my testimony make an impact on myself, & others?

Acts 26:1-18

1) We Too Are Sent To Open Eyes, Communicate Forgiveness, As Well As An Inheritance *1 Pet.2:9 *Acts 26:18

We do this *ideally* through relationships.

We also need to be equipped - "Roman's Road" - "The 3 Circles"... ("Life on Mission" *App). Also, join our "No Place Left" Team!

Your testimony has the God-given power to continue to impact you, as well as others (as seen here with Paul!). It can *strengthen* your faith. It can *embolden* you and give you God-inspired courage.

It can *help* to o<u>pen</u> people's eyes (spiritually) - turning them from darkness to light and from being under Satan's authority, to God's (*subsequent to God's sovereign*, *inner working*, *of course*).

God help us to live our faith out loud; there's a dying world that often only hears *silence* from those of the faith. May we no longer remain anonymous beyond the four walls of our church.

Acts 26:19-23

2) We Understand Through Expressing It, That The Gospel Is For Everyone, As All Need Christ's Light

From our Jerusalem, Judea and Damascus, to Gentiles a<u>broad</u> - we're to 'testify to both small and great'... Seeking to bring the light of Jesus and His gospel to a<u>ll</u>.

As we strive and push toward this great goal, it causes us to have a shift in our lives - just as it did for Paul.

In taking the gospel o<u>ut</u>, at least 3 things are happening to us: 1) We're being *changed* by our mission. 2) We're being *challenged* to press on. 3) We're becoming even more *convinced* of our message. *Rom.1:16

According to Acts 26:23, Jesus, upon His resurrection - would be the *first* to proclaim light, to both Jews *and* Gentiles. So the gospel is for everyone, because *all need* Christ's light. **John 1:4+5 + John 8:12**

*Gen.1:2+3

"Don't get angry at people in spiritual darkness for not being able to see what's obvious to you, instead - bring them some spiritual light."

Acts 26:24-29

3) Though The World May Say That You're Nuts, Stick To Sobering Truth - As It Has The Power To Persuade

Our testimony, as we point people to the truth of God's W<u>ord</u> - has power. *Acts 26:27

A changed life, that *continues* to be changed by God's Word, impacts others as well as ourselves.

Although our testimony has power to impact others, it's ultimately God's Word/God's t<u>ruth</u> (being used by the Holy Spirit), that makes the <u>greater</u> impact!

"A man once said that he had received no inspiration from the Bible, although he had gone through it several times. 'Let it go through you once', he was encouraged - 'Then you'll tell a different story!'"

Prayerfully consider who the Lord would have <u>you</u> to testify to. Then on the first of each month, <u>pray</u> for that person every day; make it a goal that by the last day of that month, you will share the gospel with them. Then from there, seek to <u>disciple</u> them. NPL!
